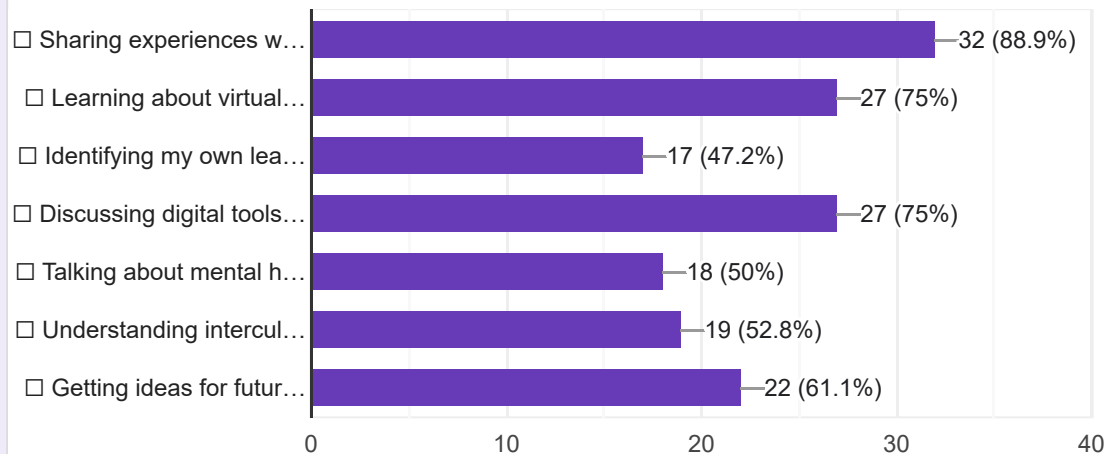

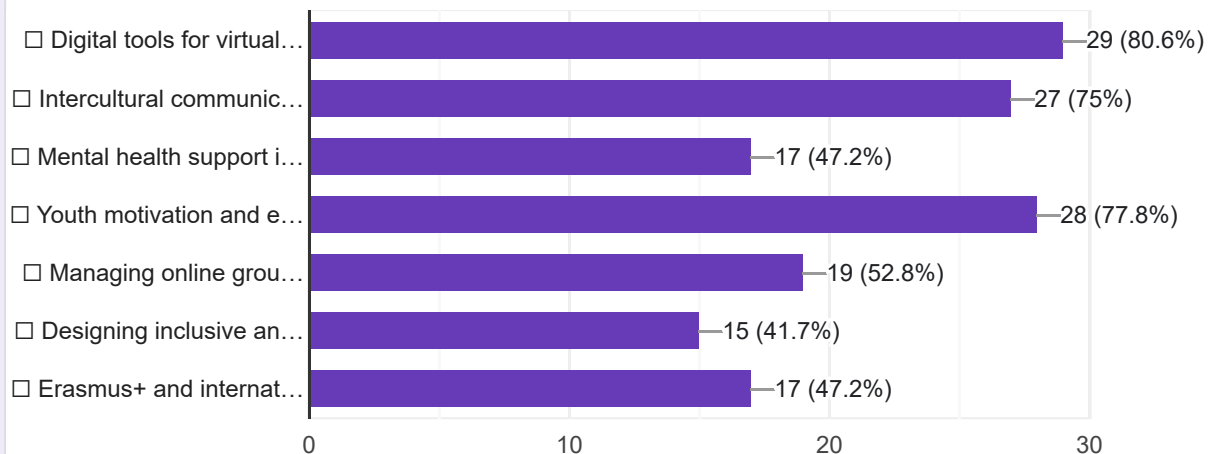


## 2 Which topics do you think should be prioritized in the upcoming training program?

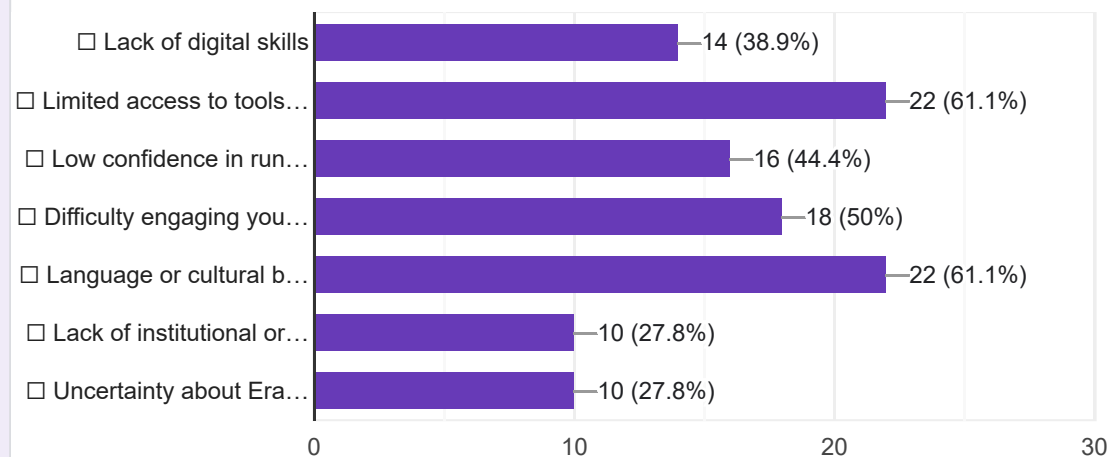

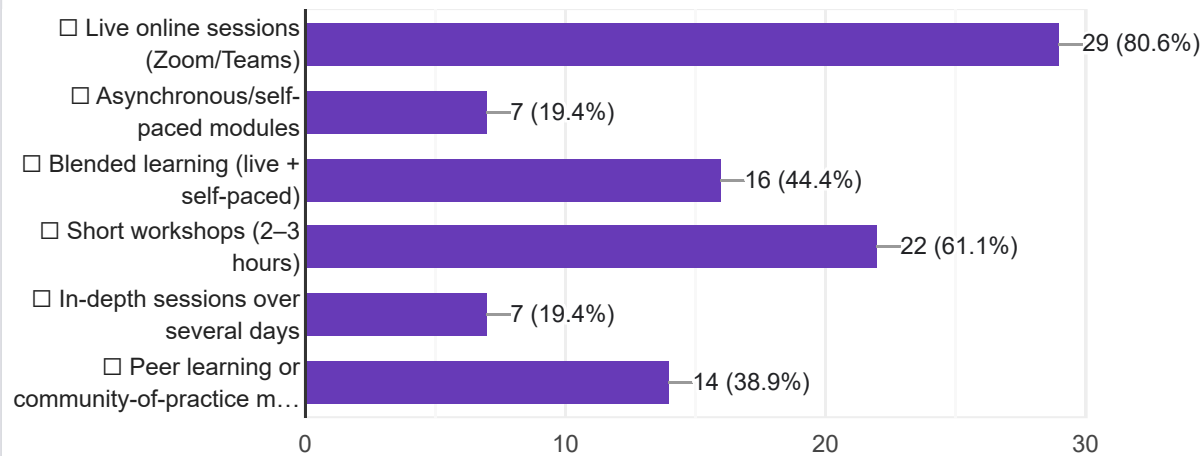

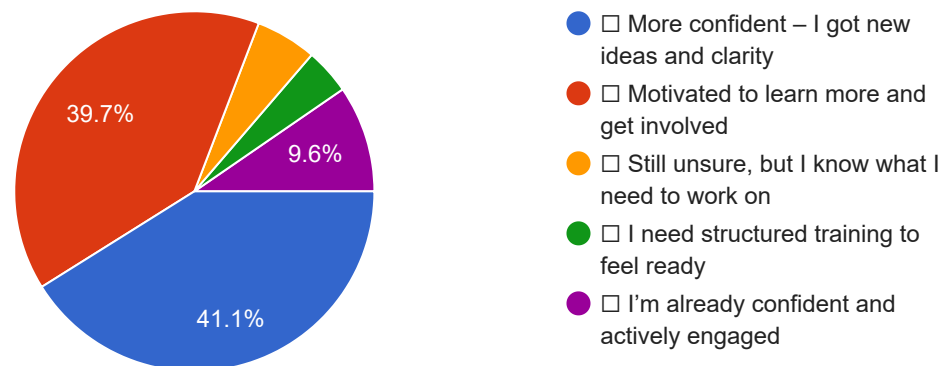
